The 2019 Rally is pleased to offer you a **new attraction**. Ride on the '*Branson Scenic Railway*' at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 30th or 2:00 p.m. on Friday May 31st, 2019. The ride boards at Branson Landing and lasts 1 hour and 45 minutes. It is a 40 mile roundtrip excursion through the panoramic Ozark foothills. You will go through tunnels and cross bridges & trestles. Your travel will be on vintage passenger cars pulled by the BSRX 98 Locomotive (1951) and the BSRX 99 Locomotive (1962) through Southwest Missouri or Northwest Arkansas. Being a commercial railroad line, The Missouri & Northern Arkansas Railroad will determine the train's direction of travel depending on the freight traffic just prior to departure. Historical narration is provided. There are 3 Budd Dome Lounge cars (1947, 1952). Seating is unassigned and you are encouraged to tour the entire train. All the cars have been restored and refurbished to offer the same first-class experience and ambiance to today's passengers as to those they carried 50 year ago. There is a concession area aboard the Silver Lake Car (1951) that offers refreshments for purchase. And of course at the end of your ride, there is a gift shop in the train depot that carries many train items. It is suggested that you make your reservations through our GWRRA Registration form as early as possible. \$26/person.

Marvel Cave

399 Indian Point Road (FREE once you purchase a Silver Dollar City Ticket)

Tours depart every 30 minutes.

Tour lasts 60 minutes

Inside Silver Dollar City – This constantly evolving wet limestone cave under Roark Mountain, dates back to the 1500's and provides a 1-hour tour of fascinating rooms and passageways. The cave's entryway is the largest in the US. The cave was found by the Osage Indians after a tribe member fell through the cave's sinkhole. Marble Cave gets its name from the marble looking ceiling. Hugo Herschend (Danish immigrant from Chicago) leased the cave in 1950 for 99 years before Silver Dollar City was even there. Silver Dollar City was literally built around the entrance of the cave.

There are nearly 600 stairs. The strenuous nature of the tour requires us to not recommend the tour for visitors with heart or lung conditions, bad backs, weak

knew or ankles. You will descend 500' below the surface. There is a unique train that will climb up ½ mile to the surface for your return.

You may even go on a **'Lantern Lighted Tour'**. Step back in time like the explorers did. Guides will dress in period costumes and delight guests. 90 minute journey each day. You will see a 'bat wall' and a Spanish ladder left in the cave from 1541. 4:30 pm for this tour and it ends at 6:00 pm. Lantern tours are \$14.00/person.
